- 3. Upper age limit will be relaxed by five years in the case of SC/ST candidates. Candidates belonging to SC/ST should submit attested copies of certificates from a competent authority to prove their status in this regard.
- 4. Candidates are advised to retain two copies of the same photograph, which was used in the application, for use at the time of written test and interview.
- 5. Mere eligibility will not vest any right / entitlement on the candidate for being called for written test / interview. In matters regarding eligibility and selection, Bank's decision will be final and **no correspondence will be entertained.**

ID) AND PASSWORD CAREFULLY FOR REPRINTING THE APPLICATION (NO E-MAIL COMMUNICATION WILL BE SENT). Keep a copy of the application form for future reference.
- 4) Paste a photograph in appropriate place and duly sign on the application print out and send it to the address given below along with demand draft and relevant documents. Write the system generated User Id (Application Ref. Id) and the name of the candidate on the back of the Demand Draft.
- 5) Super scribe the envelope containing the application "Application for the post of clerks-Kerala and Tamilnadu" and send to "Dy.General Manager(Personnel), The South Indian Bank Ltd., SIB House, Mission Quarters, Thrissur-680 001" along with Demand Draft and self attested copies of mark lists and certificates to prove qualification and age.
